I do hereby certify that the true and  
 just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within  
 the said Parish is Three Hundred and Seventy Eight pounds  
 by the year, of which sum of Three Hundred and Seventy Eight  
 pounds, One third part is due and payable to The Rev. Satham  
 Coddington as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him as  
 Incumbent of said Parish, and two third parts is due and  
 payable to the Chapter of St. Patrick Dublin as Owner  
 of said two third -

And we do further certify that the  
 average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said  
 Counties for the period of Seven years Ending on the first Day  
 of November One thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty One  
 is One pound fifteen Shillings and Eight pence Halfpenny  
 of the Pound.
