We Thomas Lancaster & Michael Caulfield Commissioners  
duly appointed under & by virtue of Acts made in the 48<sup>th</sup> of  
George the 4<sup>th</sup> entitled Acts to provide for the establishing  
Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascer-  
tain & fix a true & just composition for all Deanery tithes  
arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Moore in  
the County of Roscommon and Diocesan of Tuam do certify that  
the true & just amount of composition for all tithes whatever  
within the said Parish as agreed upon by the Very Rev<sup>d</sup> the  
Dean of Confort of the Parishioners assembled in Vestry and  
Certified by the Chairman & others and approved by the Lord  
Bishop of Tuam is twelve pounds sterling by the year  
& that the same is to continue without variation or alter-  
-ation for one & twenty years - the whole of which sum  
is due & payable to the Very Rev<sup>d</sup> Thomas Huskins, as  
Dean of Confort -
