Parish is One Hundred and six pounds and Ten pence 10^d by the year
which sum of One Hundred and six pounds and Ten pence, is due
and payable to the Rev^d Alexander Alcock as Vicar and Lessee of
the Rectorial Tithes of said Parish to the Corporation of Waterford
at the nominal rent of five Shillings per annum late Currency. I
Do further Certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn
principally grown in said County for the seven years ending the
first of November Eighteen Hundred and thirty, is One pound, twelve
Shillings and Ten pence farthing per Barrel
