amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish
is One hundred and six pounds and ten pence 4^d by the year, which
sum of One hundred and six pounds and ten pence is due and pay-
able to the Rev. Alexander Herck as Vicar and Lessee of the Rectorial
Tithes of said Parish to the Corporation of Waterford at the
rate of Five Shillings per annum. Do hereby
Certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn produce
grown in said County for the seven years ending the first of
November Eighteen hundred and thirty is One pound, twelve
Shillings and ten pence farthing per Barrel
