



In the Matter of an Application to vary  
the Tithe Rent charge of the Parish of  
Newcastle in the Diocese of Lismore in  
the County of Waterford.

Whereas it appearing to the County Court Judge and  
Chairman and Justices presiding at the Quarter Sessions  
of the Peace for the County of Waterford held at Waterford  
in the said County on the twenty third day of September  
One thousand eight hundred and ninety that the Right  
Honorable Mary Anne Grace Louisa Viscountess Doneraile  
Edmund de Poer de la Poer (Count de la Poer) and the  
Trustees of Troy's School namely the Right Reverend Maurice  
Fitzgerald Day Bishop of Waterford and the Very Reverend  
John Morgan Dean of Waterford being three land holders  
in the Parish of Newcastle in the Diocese of Lismore in  
the County of <sup>Waterford</sup> ~~Kilkenny~~ each of whom is respectively liable  
to and charged with the annual payment of the sum of  
three pounds or upwards for Rent Charge in lieu of Compo-  
sition for Tithes within the said Parish (other than Tithe  
Rent Charge which became vested in the Commissioners of  
Church Temporalities in Ireland under or by virtue of  
the Irish Church Act 1869 or the Acts amending the  
same) caused a notice in writing signed by them to be  
posted on the principal outer doors of every <sup>known</sup> place of worship  
in such Parish on two successive Sundays since the first  
day of May One thousand eight hundred and ninety that  
is to say on Sunday the thirty first day of August One  
thousand eight hundred and ninety and on Sunday the  
Seventh day of September One thousand eight hundred
