

Galway, Sept. 30th 1826

We John Mahon and James Foster
Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under
and by virtue of an act made in the fourth
year of the reign of His Majesty the fourth George
Intituled an act to provide for the establishing
of Composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited
time, and to ascertain and fix a true and just
composition for tithes arising, growing, yielding,
or payable, within the parish of Oran in the
County of Galway.

We do hereby certify that the true
and just amount of Composition for all tithes
whatsoever due and payable to the very Rev^d Warden
Daly in the said parish is three Hundred pounds
sterling by the year, three fourth parts of all tithes
whatever within said parish and payable to him
as warden of said parish of Oran for the space and
time of Twenty one years commencing the first of
November in the year of our Lord one Thousand
Eight Hundred Twenty Six.
