Observations by Commissioners

The Bishop of Kilmore is Rector and the Revd Francis Percy Vicar; The Bishop is entitled to two thirds of the Tithe namely £165.8.7 and the Vicar to one third namely £82.14.3². however it has been the practice in this Parish for the Vicar to receive the whole of the Tithes on paying the Bishop Ten Pounds Ten Shillings annually for his two thirds

No ^s	Remarks on Townlands as some of them have been assessed in the whole without particularizing the Tenants Names viz: -
24	Those three Townlands the Tenants only returned to us 115 Acres whereas they contain 146 ² -0-15 which we found out from a Survey by which the present Proprietor (Alexander McQuire Esq) purchased that property about 32 years back
25	the Tenants refused our Surveyor admittance so the above was the best evidence we could get.
26	
36	Some of the Tenants would not show us their land and those that did we perceived gave false returns - so we directed our Surveyor to measure the land He did it in the bulk but would not be allowed to survey the divisions so as near as we could view we put down the qualities leaving it to the tenants to settle the composition among themselves
79	There are seven tenants on this land however they hold it in three divisions and it is so divided, they agreed to pay the composition in that manner -
