

accordingly And whereas the said Applicants having appeared by their Counsel and Solicitor and Capt<sup>m</sup> Charles Benjamin Caldwell Esq<sup>r</sup> Lay Impropriator of the said Parish having also appeared by his Counsel and Solicitor before the Justices at such Quarter Sessions and the due service and posting of the notices required by the <sup>said</sup> Statutes in that behalf and the signatures of the said Owners thereto respectively having been duly proved and on reading a Certified Copy of the Certificate of Composition Certified by the proper officer of the Irish Land Commission for all Tithes within the said Parish bearing date the 11<sup>th</sup> day of October 1825 and also the originals of the Dublin Gazette for the seven years now last preceding And whereas it appears from the said Certificate of Composition that the average price of oats being the Corn principally grown in the said County of Meath for the period of seven years preceding the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1821 being the period in reference whereunto the said Composition was Calculated is the sum of 15<sup>7</sup>/<sub>2</sub><sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Irish Currency equal

to 14/0<sup>p</sup> Sterling per barrel of 14 stones and the average price of Oats for the period of 7 years next preceding the said application as ascertained from the said Dublin Gazette is the sum of 11<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Sterling per barrel of 14 stones being less by more than one bush than the average price for the said last-mentioned period. Now it is accordingly Ordered and adjudged that the annual rent charge in lieu of Composition for all tithes within the said Parish of Roshlinny in the County of Meath shall be diminished in such manner and to such extent that the amount of such Composition payable for and during the seven years from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November next ensuing shall bear the like proportion to the amount of the Composition set forth in the said Certificate dated the 11<sup>th</sup> day of October 1825 as the said sum of 11<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Sterling the average price of oats per barrel of 14 stones ascertained from the said Gazette for the period of 7 years preceding this
