lishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited
time, to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for
all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the
Parish of Rathmolin in the County of Meath, do hereby
Certify, that the true and just amount of Composition for all
Tithes whatever within the Said Parish is, Four hundred and
Seventy five pounds, by the year, of which the Sum of
Two hundred and Fifty pounds, are due and payable to the
Rt. Honorable John Earl of Darnley, as a Composition for the
Tithe Claimable by him as owner of the Rectorial Tithe of
Said Parish, and the Sum of Two hundred and Twenty five
pounds, is due and payable to the Rev Samuel Magee
the Vicar of Said parish, for all Tithes Claimable by him
as Vicar, the Said Composition to take place from the
date hereof and be in force for the term of 21 Years
without any alteration from the average price of Corn or
