 Certify that I have viewed all parts of Said Parish and caused
 to be brought before me all existing Surveys and Maps which
 I conceived to be necessary to enable me to make a fair
 Composition for the payment of tithes in said Parish and where
 none existed I caused a Survey to be made and exclusive
 of all wastes find that the Parish contains Two Thousand
 Seven Hundred & Seventy Acres and One perch Irish plantation
 Measure which is equal to Four Thousand Four Hundred and
 eighty five Acres two roods and twenty five perches Statute
 Measure that are subject to the payment of Composition
 for tithes, and the sum assessed and apportioned on said Parish
 is Forty Six pounds fifteen Shillings and four pence three
farthings which is payable solely to the Incorporated Society
 I have divided the several lands into three classes the
 first to pay at the rate of six pence of Irish acre the
 second to pay four pence farthing and the third Two
 pence three farthings of Irish acre and is fully stated
 in the Annexed Book - Given under my hand this 4
 day of May 1833 three
