vested and reposed in me, as a Commissioner in the
Parish of Saint Peter's in the County of the Town of
Drogheda, by Virtue of an Act passed in the fourth
year of the Reign of King George the fourth Entituled
An Act to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for
Tithes in Ireland for a limited Time, and also
by Virtue of an Act passed in the fifth year of
the Reign of his said Majesty. Entituled An Act
to amend an Act of the last Session of Parliament
for Providing for the Establishing of Compositions for
Tithes in Ireland, according to the Direction of the
said Act, and according to Equity and good Conscience
and without favour, or affection, prejudice, or Malice
to any person or persons whomsoever.
