all tithes whatever within the said Parish is Three Hundred Pounds  
British Stg by the year, which sum is due and payable to the  
Representatives of the late Isaac Norman as lay Impropriators  
of the said Parish And we do further Certify that the average  
price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in such County  
for the period of Seven Years ending on the first day of November  
One thousand Eight hundred and Twenty One is fifteen Shillings  
and two pence halfpenny late Irish currency or fourteen Shillings  
and one halfpenny present currency of Barrell Dated this  
first day of March 1828
