

I Charles Percival having been duly appointed and
sworn Commissioner under and by virtue of an Act
made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the
Fourth, intitled, An Act to amend three Acts passed
respectively, in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and
eighth years of the reign of His late Majesty King George
the Fourth, Providing for the establishing of Compositions
for Tithes in Ireland; and to make such Compositions
permanent. - 16th August 1832 - to ascertain and fix a true
and just Composition for all Tithes arising, yielding, growing,
or payable within the Parish of Shankhill in the County
of Wicklow. - do hereby certify that the true and
just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever
within the said Parish is Four Hundred and Thirty
five Pounds by the year, which sum of Four Hun-
-dred and Thirty five Pounds is due and payable
to the Reverend Joseph Chapman as a Composition
for
