

Certificate of Commissioners.

We ~~John~~ Messrs of Barrington, Co of Kildan
and Bartholomew Ellis of Mariaville Co. of
Kildan, Commissioners duly appointed and
sworn under and by virtue of an Act made
in the fourth year of the Reign of King
George the fourth entitled "an Act to provide
for the establishing of Compositions, for Tithes
in Ireland for a limited time" do hereby
Certify, that at a Special Vestry held ac-
cording to the provisions of the said act, in
the Parish of Taghadee on the 24th day of
March 1829, it was then and there agreed
upon and confirmed (the consent of His
Grace the Lord Archbishop of Dublin, and
of the Corporation of the City of Dublin, having
been previously obtained) between the said
George Blount, the Rector and Vicar of said
Parish and the Parishioners then assembled,
that the fixed yearly sum of Two hundred
Twenty Pounds, Sterling present Currency,
be the true and just amount of composition
for all Tithes, arising, growing, yielding, or
payable within the Parish of Taghadee,
in County of Kildan, and it was further
agreed upon that such composition shall
be invariable for the term of twenty one
Years from the 1st day of May next, ensuing
the date hereof and that such composition
shall continue to be levied for such term
of twenty one Years and shall not be subject
to any variation in the account thereof,
during such period of twenty one Years
under the provisions, of said ^{recited act or this} Act, whatever
the price of Corn may be
