in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and
just composition for all the Tithes arising growing yielded or
payable within the parish of Tuckmacumera the County of
Roscommon do hereby certify that the sum agreed on by the
Incumbent and Vestry as the amount of Composition for all
Tithes whatever within the said parish is one hundred
and sixty pounds Sterling - - - by the year
of which sum of one hundred & sixty Pounds Sterling
four pounds are due and payable to the very Rev^d Dean
Armitage as Dean of Clonfert as a composition for the Tithes
claimable by him -

One hundred and sixteen pounds Sterling
being Threefourths of the Residue are due and payable to the
Rev^d Pat^r Bourden as Rector of said parish -

Thirty nine pounds sterling
being one fourth of said Residue is due and payable to the Right
Rev^d Christopher the Lord Bishop of the Diocese of Clonfert and
we do further certify that the Average price of Oats being
the Corn growing in such County for the period of seven years
ending on the 1st day of Nov. 1821 is £0..15. 2¹/₄ p Barrel
