Commissioners duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of King ^{George} the fourth intituled an Act for ~~the~~ ^{the} establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a ~~law~~ ^{law} ~~and~~ ^{and} composition for all the tithes arising growing yields or payable within the parish of Tachmacumna in the County of Roscommon do hereby certify that the sum agreed on by the incumbent and vestry as the amount of composition for all tithes whatever within the said parish is one hundred and

sixty pounds sterling by the year, of which sum of one hundred and fifty pounds - four pounds are due and payable to the very Rev. Dean

Hawkins as Dean of Clonfert as a composition for the tithes claimable by him -

One hundred and seventeen pounds Sterling being threefourths of the Residue and due and payable to the Rev. Pat. Pouden as Rector of said parish -

Thirty nine pounds Sterling

being onefourth of said Residue is due & payable to the Right Rev. Christopher ^{Lord} Bishop of the Diocese of Clonfert and

we do further certify that the average price of Oats being the Corn growing in such County for the period of seven years ending on the 1st day of Nov. 1824 is £0. 15. 2¹/₄ of Barrel as per Dublin Gazette.
