

We Richard Sevinge Esq. and Richard Ryan Com-
missioners duly appointed and Sworn under and by virtue
of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King
George the fourth intituled, "an act to provide for the
establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a
limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just Com-
position for all tithes arising growing yielded or payable
within the parish of Toghmore in the County of West-
meath do hereby Certify, That the true and just
amount of Composition for all tithes whatever within
the said parish is one hundred and sixty six
pounds thirteen Shillings by the year of which
sum of one hundred and sixty six pounds thirteen
Shillings the whole is due and payable to the Rev.
Benedict Hall as Rector of said Parish.

And we do further Certify that the average
price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in
such County for the period of seven years ending
on the 1st Day of Nov. 1820 is fifteen Shillings
and two pence farthing per barrel
