Copy of Certificate of Tithe Composition.

We, Francis Robert Cotton, of Prospect in the County of Dublin, and George Wharton of Meadow Bank, in the said County Esq^{rs}, Commissioners, duly appointed and sworn, under and by Virtue of an Act, made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, entitled, "An act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes, in Ireland for a limited time", and of an Act made in the Fifth year of His said Majesty's Reign, entitled, "An act, to amend an act of the last Session of Parliament, for providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland," to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition, for all Tithes, arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Tallaght, in the County of Dublin, do hereby Certify, that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish, is Six Hundred and Seventy Eight pounds, eighteen shillings and Six pence British Currency by the year, being equal in amount to the sum of Seven hundred and thirty five pounds, ten shillings of the late Irish Currency, of which sum of Six hundred and Seventy eight pounds, eighteen shillings and Six pence— Three hundred and Sixty nine pounds, four shillings, and Seven
