under and by virtue of an act made in the Fourth  
year of the Reign of King George the Fourth  
intituled an act to provide for the establishing  
Compositions for tythes in Ireland for a limited  
time to ascertain and fix the true and just  
composition for all tythes arising growing yielded  
or payable within the parish of Troughbay in the  
Counties of Roscommon and Galway. Do hereby  
certify that the true and just amount of Com-  
position for all tythes whatever within the said  
parish is one hundred and five pounds by the  
year of which sum of £105, Forty two pounds  
are due and payable to the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> The Inco-  
orporated Society as lay Impropriators of said parish  
and sixty three pounds is due and payable to The  
Hon<sup>ble</sup> and Rev<sup>d</sup>. Marcus Henry Crofton the Vicar  
as owner of the vicarial tythes of said parish  
and we do further certify that the average price  
of oats being the corn principally grown in such  
counties for the period of seven years ending  
thirty first day of December Eighteen Hundred and twenty  
one was fifteen shillings and two pence per bushel  
in the City of Dublin
