Lyster Esq^r, the Commissioner appointed
by the owners and occupiers of land within said
parish of Tetsaragh for the purposes of the Act
of Parliament of the fifth year of King George
the fourth, chap 99, entitled, "An act to provide
for the establishing Compositions for tithes in
Ireland, for a limited time."

-tors of tithes in said parish, to treat with Rich^d.
Keoghe of Feick, Esq^r, the Commissioner appointed
by the owners and occupiers of land within
said parish, for the ascertaining and making
a composition for all tithes Impropriate, Rectorial,
Vicarial, Predial Personal or Mixed, within
said parish of Disert, whether payable to
Rector, Vicar, Body corporate, or politic, or any
other person, or persons whatsoever Lay or Eccle-
-siastical, and for all the purposes of the Act of
Parliament of the 4th year of George the 4th,
Chap 99, entitled, "An act to provide for the
composition of tithes in Ireland for a
limited time."
