



Whereas William Haslett of the City of
 Londonderry Sheriff did pursuant to the
 provisions of the Statute hereafter mentioned
 cause to be delivered unto the Reverend Edward
 Bowen Rector of the Parishes of All Saints
 andoughboyne in the Diocese of Raphoe
 a notice in writing in the words following
 "Reverend Sir I beg leave to give you notice
 "pursuant to the provisions of the Statute made
 "and passed in the second and third years of the
 "reign of his present Majesty King William
 "the fourth entitled an act to amend the laws
 "passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the
 "reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the establishing of
 "Compositions for tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent That
 "I am desirous to agree for and undertake as provided by the said act upon your
 "performing the matters and things prescribed and enacted by the said act to
 "be done and performed on your part the future payment of the Tithe Compositions
 "issuable and payable out of the Town lands or parts of Town lands and tenements
 "as described in the map a true exact and ground plan annexed to this notice first
 "deducting thereout the fifth part Centum on the amount as provided by the said act
 "and I hereby require you in pursuance of the provisions of said act to grant to me
 "with all convenient speed a Certificate under your hand and seal of the import required
 "by the said act and in order that I may execute under my hand and seal the
 "Declaration of the Import required by the said act in the manner therein directed
 "and I give you notice that I am ready in Fee Farms of the rent and valuation
 "of the said lands and premises and that I am ready to give you any further
 "Information in relation thereto which you may require upon receiving any
 "notice from you for the purpose given under my hand this sixteenth day of February
 "one thousand eight hundred and thirty three - William Haslett - To the Reverend Edward
 "Bowen Rector of the Parishes of All Saints andoughboyne Diocese of Raphoe and
 "County of Donegal"

Now I the said Reverend Edward Bowen in pursuance of said Statute do
 hereby certify and declare that the above named William Haslett is entitled to agree for and
 undertake the future payment of the Composition charged on and issuing and payable out
 of the lands mentioned and described in said notice and in the Map ground plan or sketch
 hereto annexed pursuant to the desire signified in said notice and that he is entitled to the benefit
 thereof In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty third day of
