

To Sir Robt. Mahon, Baronet

Sir I hereby certify that I have received your letter bearing date the 24th day of October last purporting that you are desirous of agreeing for and undertaking the future payment of the Tithe payable to me out of the Lands of Tarmunbarry otherwise Ballyteohy containing five hundred and twenty Acres late Irish measure or thereabouts and Bounded on the North by Mr. Nesbitts property on the East by the River Shannon on the West by Mr. Nesbitts property and on the South by the River Shannon of which said lands you therein state yourself to be seized in fee of one moiety and of the other moiety under a lease of lives Renewable for ever. And I hereby also certify that I accept of the above proposal and hereby agree to the terms thereof and declare that you the above named Sir Robt. Mahon Baronet are entitled to the benefit thereof pursuant to the Statute in such case provided, given under my hand and seal this 8th day of February 1833
