All a vestry called by public notice according to the Tenor of the Act of the fourth of George the fourth Chapter 99. for the purpose of bringing the Parish of Rathbrook under the provisions of said Act

It was resolved -

That the Landholders of said Parish agree to pay to the Clerical Incumbent of said Parish the sum of Seventeen pounds ten Shillings Sterling per Annum in two Half yearly payments on the first day of May and first day of November in each year -

This agreement to continue in force for the space of Twenty One years -

That the said Landholders agree also to pay the sum of Thirty five pounds per Annum according to the tenor of the above Agreement to the Lessee of the Mirror Armons of Saint Patrick's Church Dublin.

Date this 5th Day of July 1827 Seven -

That the Rev. John Bagot is hereby appointed Commissioner on the part of the Landholders of said Parish.
