You are hereby required to take Notice, that in pursuance of an Act passed in the 2nd and 3rd Years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled, "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th, and in the 7th and 8th years of the Reign of his late Majesty, King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," I, Gracious Decree of Her Majesty in the County of Sligo, Legend to and for Sir Alexander Crichton who is seized in The Lissippe of all that and those the Township of Mount Durrowe containing One Hundred and Twenty three Acres English Statute Measure or thereabout, the Meaws and bounds whereof are delineated and set forth in the Map or Survey Chart hereto annexed which Lands are situated in the Parish of Tuam, Barony of Tuam, and County of Sligo.

lawfully payable for and in respect of the said Lands, and I hereby require you to grant to the said
Sir Alexander Colclough a Certificate in writing conformable to the Provisions of the said Act, declaring
him entitled to the benefit of this Notice, and to perform the other mat-

vers on your part required by the said Act to be done.
