I Christopher Ryan, Commissioner duly appointed  
and sworn ~~under~~ and by virtue of an Act made  
in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year of the Reign of King William the  
Fourth intituled "An Act to Amend three Acts passed  
respectively in the 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and in the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> years  
of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the 4<sup>th</sup>  
providing for the establishing of Compositions  
for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Com-  
positions Permanent." to ascertain and fix  
a true and just Composition for all Tithes  
arising growing yielded or Payable within  
the Parish of Inyernan and County of Westmeath.  
Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount  
of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within  
the sd. Parish is Thirty Six Pounds <sup>35</sup> <sup>18</sup> <sup>6</sup> <sup>5</sup> by the year  
which sum is due and Payable to Sir John Piers  
as a Composition for the Tithe claimable by him  
as owner of the Rectorial Tithe of sd. Parish.  
And I do further Certify that the Average Price  
of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in  
such County for the Period of seven years ending  
on the 1<sup>st</sup> of November 1830 - is £1. 12. 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> per Bush.
