A Calculation of the Tithes of Parish of Wells, as appraised under the Tithes Composition Bill, Whereas the Land is divided into three qualities the 1st at 5/8 the 2d at 4/7 1/4 and the 3d at 3/4 1/2 p^r Acre, to make p^r 425, being the Average Sum taken from the 7 Years produce of Tithes in said Parish, and which averages at 5s 2 1/2 p^r Acre, also a second Calculation, to make £300, which is the sum, the Double and Very Good, Good, Boyle Bernard considered to take p^r Year, during the Next three Years the 1st Quality at 3s 10 1/2, the 2d at 3s 3, and the 3d at 2s 8 1/2 p^r Acre, and which averages at 3s 8 1/2 p^r Acre,
