

I Chandos Morwyns Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Years of the Reign of King William the 3<sup>rd</sup> entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> years of the Reign of His Late Majesty King George the 4<sup>th</sup> providing for the establishing of Composition for tithes in Ireland and to make such composition permanent, to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielding or payable within the parish of Kiltoran in the County of Kilkenny, do hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition for all tithes whatever within the said parish is £34.0.0 by the year which sum of £ 34.0.0  
is due and payable to the Revd Hance Hamilton as a composition for the tithe claimable by him as Rector of the said parish. And I do further certify that the average price of Wheat being the corn principally grown in such County for 7 years ending on the first day of November 1830 is £1.12.0 per Barrel
