

We John Wilson of the Tolls in
the County of Donegal and Robert Howard Nolan
of the City of Londonderry Commissioners duly appointed
and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the
Fourth Year of the Reign of King George ^{the Fourth} entitled
"An Act to provide for the establishing of Composition of Tithes
in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a
true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded
or payable within the Parish of Aughinish in the County of
Donegal.

Do hereby certify that the true ^{and just} amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish
is Five Hundred and nine Pounds, Seven Shillings and
Four pence Sterling by the Year British Currency being the
present Currency of the County the entire of which Sum is
due and payable to the Reverend Dr Cornelius Henry Usher
Rector of said Parish and to his Successors as a Compensation for the Tithes
claimed by him as such the said Annual Sum of Five Hun-
dred and Nine Pounds Seven Shillings and Four Pence Ster-
ling being the just and fair proportion (According to our Val-
uation) of the Sum of Eleven Hundred Pounds Sterling
which Sum of Eleven Hundred Pounds Sterling was agreed
upon by Special Vestry duly assembled to be the Sum to
be paid to the said Rector out of the two Parishes of Tubby
and Aughinish and which Sum was accepted of and assented
to by said Rector the Bishop of the Diocese and Trinity Col-
lege as Patron.

And said Composition is to commence and take effect from
the first day of November next and to continue and be in
