We John Mearns of Glyncourt, and John Mahon of Rennie in the County of Galway Esquires Commissioners, duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth entitled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Bullane in the County of Galway do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Twenty four pounds Sterling by the year of which sum of Twenty four pounds, twenty three pence Sterling are due and payable to the Rev. James Carrigan as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Vicarary of said Parish and his Successors. Eleven pounds Sterling are due and payable to the Rev. John Burke as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as vicar of said Parish and his Successors.

We do further certify that the average price of Oats being the corn principally grown in such County for the period of Seven years ending on the 1st day of November 1827 one is ten Shillings and Six pence by the Bush.
