the true and just amount of Composition for
all Tithes what - within such parish - is
Three hundred - and Sixty eight pounds -
Seventeen Shillings and five pence Halfpenny
by the Year: the said Composition is
due and payable to the Reverend Mr. Morgan
as a Composition for the Tithes Annually by him
an Incumbent of said parish -

We further certify that the average price of
Oats - being the Corn - principally grown in said
Counties - for the period of seven years - ending 1st
November 1821 - is fifteen Shillings and 2 ¹/₄
per Barrel.
