


We George Rowan and Samuel M. Nicolson Esquires Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth and fifth years of the Reign of King George the fourth, to ascertain and fix a true and Just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the parish of Garfina in the Diocese of Limerick Sheriff and County of Kerry. Do Certify hereby, that the true and Just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said parish, is one hundred and thirty eight pounds nine Shillings and two pence half penny by the year, of which sum Ninety two pounds Six Shillings and One penny three farthings, being the two thirds, is due and payable to the Right Hon^{ble} W^m Maron Lord Ventry, as Lay Rector and Improvitor of said parish, and ^{six} forty pounds Three Shillings and One penny, being the one third of said sum of one hundred and thirty eight pounds nine Shillings and two pence half penny by the year is due and payable to the Rev^d Thomas Jefferson as Vicar of said parish.

And we further Certify that the average price of Oats, being the Corn principally grown for the period of Seven years ending the first Day of November 1821. was Fifteen Shillings and two pence farthing per Barrel of Fourteen Stone, Dated this 14th Day of July 1826
