

Wright the Rector and Vicar of the said Parish of Grangeford and
Chapman the said William Raymond Fitzmaurice having at this Quarter
Sessions same being held at Carlisle agreed on the said 1st day of
January 1835 delivered to the Justices presiding at this Sessions the
Report in writing under his hand whereby he gave us to understand
and informed us that the average price of good marketable wheat
for the seven years next preceding the 1st day of November in said year
1834 was £1. 7. 1½ British Money per Barrel and appearing to us
the Justices aforesaid presiding at this Court of Quarter Sessions so being
held at Carlisle aforesaid made for the County of Carlisle aforesaid
on the said 1st day of January 1835 by the Certificate bearing
date the 21st day of September 1833 as well as by the original
assessment and apportionment of the Commissioners aforesaid under
the acts of his late Majesty entitled the 4th Geo. 4th Chap. 94 and
5th Geo. 4th Chap 63 passed by the Legislature of the Diocese of
Liegthon in the County of Carlisle in which said Parish is situate
and given in Evidence before us by Son behalf of the said Appraisers
and also given in Evidence and relied on by said Rev^r Robert Wright
the said Rector and Vicar of said Parish that the average price of
wheat per Barrel for the seven years preceding the first day of November
1830 was £12.0. It is also further in consequence thereof that the said
Commissioners had fixed the amount of the Composition for the
in said Parish of Grangeford at £264.0.0 annually due & payable
as in said Certificate of 21st day of September 1833 mentioned above
further appearing to us the said Justices assembled at this Quarter
Sessions of the Peace for the County of Carlisle held at Carlisle
in the County of Carlisle on the 1st day of January 1835 that the
said Earl of Brougham Thomas Cobden and James Hardy Justice
have supported by Evidence their application an order having enquired
into the same and so appearing to us that the Commissioners
appointed under the 4th and 5th Geo 4th Chap. 94 the sum in the said
Parish
