of which Sum of One Hundred and Twelve Pounds ten Shillings
the Eighty eight Pounds are due and payable to the Vicar
Parson and Curate as Rector and Vicar of the said Parish, and his suc-
cessors; and Twenty four Pounds ten Shillings are due
and payable to the Bishop of the Diocese of Confert and Kilmacduagh
and do further Certify that the above Composition is to remain
unaltered for and during the space of Twenty one years,
commencing from the first of Novem^r 1828 - Dated this
