

The John Bagot Esq^r and the Rev^d John Bagot
Commissioners duly appointed and sworn by virtue of two acts made
in the fourth and fifth years of the Reign of King George the fourth,
the entitled acts to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for
Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain and fix a
true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yeeloc,
or payable within the Parish of Mauricetownbiller in the County
of Kildare to the Rector of the said Parish, do hereby certify that
the true and just amount of Composition for all the portion of
Tithes whatever within the said Parish and payable to the said Rector
is Eighty five pounds by the year, the entire of which sum is payable
to the Rev^d William Vandecture, as a Composition for all Tithes
claimed by him as Rector of said Parish

And we do further certify that the average price of Wheat
(being the corn principally grown in said County for the period of seven
years ending the first day of November one thousand eight hundred
and twenty one) is one pound fifteen and eight pence three farthings
per barrel.
