

We John Dwyer and John Lithgow Com-
missioners duly appointed and sworn under
and by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth
year of the Reign of King George the Fourth
intitulated an Act to provide for the establishing
of compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a
limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just
composition for all Tithes arising growing yield-
ing or payable within the Parish of Upper
Morville in the County of Down. As which
certify that the true and just amount
of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within
the said Parish is Two Hundred and Fifty five
Pounds British, by a agreement by the year
to continue for the term of Twenty One years
from the first day of November next, which
sum is due and payable annually to the Rev.
John M. Staples and his successors Rectors
of said Parish for the space of Twenty One
years. The said Rev. John M. Staples being
the only claimant of Tithes in said Parish.
