I Goerge Rowan do swear that I am seized of a Leasehold Estate in the Lands of Upper and Lower Ratanny and Minothee, whereof not less than fourteen years are unexpired, which are together of the annual value of Two hundred pounds and upwards, and that said lands are situate in the Parish of BallyMcElligott and Barony of Pughenacking in the County of Kerry and are bona fide my property - So help me God.

I Francis Walker do swear that I will faithfully, impartially and honestly according to the best of my skill and ability execute and perform the powers and authorities vested and ~~ex~~posed in me as Commissioner in the Parish of O'Brenan by virtue of an Act passed in the fourth year of the reign of King Goerge the Fourth entitled an Act to provide for the establishing of compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, according to the directions of the said Act and according to equity and good conscience and without favour or affection, predudice or malice to any person or persons whomsoever. So help me God. Sworn before me this 19th day of March 1825.
