of King George the fourth entitled an Act to provide
for establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for
a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just
composition for all tithes arising growing yielding
or payable within the Parish of Rathvilly and
County of Carlow, do hereby certify that the true and
just amount of such composition for all tithes whatever
within the said Parish of Rathvilly is Eight hundred
and fifty pounds of the late Irish currency - which sum
is due and payable to the Rev^d John Whitty as
composition for the tithes claimed by him, as owner of
the Rectorial and Vicarial Tithes of said Parish

and We do further certify that the average
price of Oats, being the Corn principally grown in
that part of said County for the period of seven years
preceding the 1st day of November 1821. is 15. and 2/3
per Barrel
