

Certificate

I the Reverend John Wether D. D. Incumbent of the Parish of Raymohy, County of Donegal having received from John Callaghan of Galdenagh in the said Parish a Notice in the Words and Figures following

Rev. Sir, You are requested to take Notice that in pursuance of an Act of Parliament passed in the 2<sup>d</sup> & 3<sup>d</sup> Years of the Reign of his present Majesty King William the fourth entitled, an Act to amend the Acts passed respectively in the 2<sup>d</sup> 3<sup>d</sup> and in the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the 4<sup>th</sup>, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland & to make such Compositions permanent I am desirous to agree for & undertake the future payment of the tithe Composition charged & payable upon the lands following Viz. that part of the townland of Mandoory now in my possession bounded on the North by the townland of Drumcairn, on the South by that part of the townland of Mandoory in the possession of James Rodgers on the East by the townland of Drumoghill and on the West by that part of the townland of Mandoory in the possession of Hugh McDavid and that part of the townland of Drumcairn in the possession of Alexander Lecky, containing forty four Acres or thereabouts Cunningham Measure. Situate in the parish of Raymohy & held by a lease for the term of twenty one years & I hereby request you to grant me with all convenient speed a Certificate in writing conformable to the provisions of said Act declaring me entitled to the Benefit of this Notice, in order that I may execute under my hand and Seal the declaration of the importance required by the said Act and I am ready when receiving Notice from you to do & perform all the other Acts which may be required in relation to this Notice.
