appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made  
in the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth  
intituled an act to provide for the establishment of Corn Provisions  
for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix  
a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing  
giddings or payable within the Parish of St. Johns in the  
County of Newcomen do hereby certify that the true and just  
amount of composition for all Tithes whatsoever within said  
Parish is one thousand and twenty two pounds fourteen shillings  
and five pence British currency by the year of which sum of  
one thousand and twenty two pounds fourteen shillings and five  
pence the sum of sixty two pounds fourteen shillings and five  
pence is due and payable to the Reverend Canon Galahad as a  
composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Vicar of the  
said Parish and the sum of sixty pounds to the Incorporated  
Society as a composition for the Tithes claimable by them

And We do further certify that the average price of  
Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said Parish  
for the period of seven years ending the first of Nov 1825  
was fourteen shillings and six pence per bush
