duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an
Act made in the 2^d and 3^d Years of the Reign of William
the 4th to ascertain and fix a true and Just Composition
for all Tithes arising, growing, upholding, or payable
within the Parish of Taghskine in the Diocese of
Armagh and in the County of Longford.

do Certify that the true and Just Amount of Com-
position for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish
is Two Hundred and Thirty Pounds and three pence
and one farthing sterling by the Year. Being the
Average of the seven Years preceding the first of
November 1830 which of which sum the Rev. William
C. Armstrong as Rector of said Parish is entitled to
One Hundred and fifty six pounds four shillings and
two pence halfpenny sterling. And the said Rev. W.
C. Armstrong as Vicar of the Abbey-lands
of Abbeydorney in said Parish is entitled to Thirteen
pounds eleven shillings and nine pence halfpenny
sterling. And the Countess Dowager of Rosse is
entitled to the Remainder of the said Tithes of the
Abbey lands of Abbeydorney as Lay Impropriator.

And that the said Rev. William C. Armstrong
as Vicar of the Townlands of Taghsham and Torboy
in said Parish is entitled to Twelve pounds eighteen
shillings and nine pence sterling. And Messrs
Ponsonby and Pollison, are supposed to be entitled
to have been over
