an act of the last session of Parliament for providing for the establishing
of composition for tithes in Ireland to ascertain and fix a true and just
composition for all tithes growing arising yielded or payable within the
Parish of Little Malton in the County of Shelburne

Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of
Composition for all tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Twenty
four pounds & 3 shillings by the year of which sum of twenty four pounds
two thirds or sixteen pounds are due and payable to Mr John Gould as a
composition for the tithe claimable by him as lay impropriator and
one third or eight pounds is due and payable to the Rev^d John
Thornel Dean of Elphin as a composition for the tithe claimable
by him as Rector of the said Parish to be continued invariable for twenty
one years - And we do further Certify that the average price of wheat
being the corn principally grown in such County for the Period of
Seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 is Thirty Shillings
per Barrell -
