STATE OF ENGLAND.

The manufacturing districts of England are in a distressed and agitated condition. A general outbreak of rioting has been commenced or a scale of such magnitude as might be expected from that great capital on an occasion. Meanwhile, the measure for grain under his Majesty's own proceedings, but encounter considerable opposition from the both Houses.

Extract of a letter from Manchester, dated

"I am sorry to say every thing here is as bad as ever; such a scene I never witnessed, and never expected to see this town in such a state. Mobs are constantly parading the streets in all parts, and hold the authorities completely at defiance. All trade is suspended. Robberies are committed in open with impunity; demands are made upon shopkeepers, and in some instances upon private families. What end will be I cannot imagine."

From another Letter.

"Nothing can exceed the miserable state we are in. The police appear to be completely overpowered, and the constant cry through the streets is, 'Murder! Murder!'"

"You may rely upon it, as far as I can see, that the

"whole of the manufacturing districts are in a state of anarchy, and the demands for payment of wages have been suspended within a fortnight."
