We, Joseph Cooke, and James Rae being duly appointed commissioners, for the composition and appportionment of the Parish of Rathnaveen, having fixed the rate of composition thereof, at two hundred and seventy six pounds eighteen and five pence half penny, do hereby certify, that to the best of our knowledge, the said parish contains two thousand six hundred and thirty eight wheat Irish acres, and we do therefore assess each acre to pay at the rate of two shillings and one penny farthing, and so in proportion for woods and parks - the same to be levied in each year upon the foregoing occupiers of the respective lands in said parish, according to the act in that behalf made and provided as witness our hands this five tenth day of December one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight
