by the Year, of which Sum of *one hundred & forty Pounds Sterling*

Seventy Pounds Sterling — is due and payable to *The Rev. Oliver Geary* — as a Composition claimable by him as *Vicar* — of said Parish, *Lumna* — and *Seventy pounds Sterling* —

as Composition claimable by him — is due and payable to *Lord Viscount Lorton* — as *Lay Proprietor* of said Parish *Lumna*

And I do further Certify, that the average price of Oats—being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of Seven Years, ending the First Day of November, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty—is

Twelve Shillings & Eleven pence—per Barrel. *Dated this 1st Day*
